# **TRAINEE ELECTRO TECHNICAL OFFICER (Trainee ETO)**

# 1. Trainee ETO:

### **Eligibility:**

- Should have been born after 1 Jan 1995
- The candidate should have completed an Electro Technical Officer course from a DGS recognized Maritime Training Institute.
- Candidates should be fresher, i.e., should not have sailed priorly.
- Candidates who are currently pursuing ETO course are **NOT ELIGIBILE** for this exam.

#### **Entrance Exam for Recruitment of Trainee ETO 2025 Examination syllabus:**

- The examination will be a Test center-based exam which is planned on 14 December 2025, at candidate's nearest city/center from the options given.
- The Examination duration will be 3 hours (180 minutes).
- The examination will comprise of 200 MCQ (Multiple Choice Questions) inclusive of 100 Knowledge based questions (ETO Syllabus) and 100 English & Aptitude-based questions.
- Each question answered correctly is awarded 1 mark. There is a negative marking of 0.25 for every wrong answer. No marks are awarded or deducted for un-attempted questions.

### **Question Pattern**

Section A - Knowledge - 100 MCQ (MCQ based on ETO Syllabus)

Section B – English and Aptitude - 100 MCQ (Numerical Reasoning and Data Interpretation, Verbal Reasoning, Nonverbal reasoning (Spatial and Abstract Reasoning) & English)

- 1. Kindly note that the selection procedure involves the candidates clearing the Entrance Examination, Medicals, Interview & Psychometrics, and Document verification.
- 2. Applications are open for both male and female candidates.

# 2. GME Sponsorship

Entrance Exam for Sponsoring of Mechanical engineering Graduates for Graduate Marine Engineer (GME) program

NOTE: Sponsorship is only for placement of candidates in IMU approved pre-sea training institutes and DOES NOT INCLUDE FEES for the candidate.

### **Eligibility:**

- Should have born on or after 1 December 1997
- As on commencement of course the candidate should not be more than 28 years of age
- Should have scored minimum 60% Overall Aggregate in Class XII
- Should have obtained minimum 50% marks in English in Class XII or equivalent.
- Should have completed B TECH / BE in Mechanical Engineering with minimum 60% aggregate.
- Candidates who have completed a degree in all Naval Architecture streams can also apply but must meet minimum requirement of 60% overall degree percentage.
- Candidates pursuing final year of B TECH / BE in Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture are not eligible for this
  exam

### **Examination syllabus for Recruitment of Graduate Marine Sponsorship EXAM 2025:**

- The examination will be of the online format of duration 3 hours (180 minutes).
- The examination will be of the objective type comprising of 200 questions. A total of 100 questions will test technical knowledge and 100 questions to test English and aptitude.
- Each question answered correctly is awarded 1 mark and every question answered incorrectly is awarded 0.25 negative mark. Un-attempted questions are not marked (no plus or minus marks).
- Testing Areas for Technical knowledge: (100 questions)
  - Syllabus Based B TECH/ BE Mechanical engineering (Mechanical Engineering Gate Syllabus)
